

## Mobile World Congress Competition Terms and Conditions

### Entry

1. The Mobile World Congress (**MWC**) competition ( the “Competition”) is open worldwide to all, aged 18 years or over, except employees of Canonical, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the Competition.
2. By entering the Competition, you agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions. Any entries not complying with the Terms and Conditions will not be valid.
3. The Competition is free to enter and no purchase is necessary.
4. You enter into the Competition by telling or showing Canonical what you are most excited about seeing at MWC, on Twitter using the hashtag **#UbuntuAtMWC**. Your Competition Entry can use text, visuals or videos – anything that fits in a tweet. Only one Competition Entry per person will be permitted.
5. The Competition will open on 5 January 2017 at [16:30] and close on 12th January 2017 at [23:55]. Any Competition Entries submitted after the closing date and time will not be considered.

### Winner notification and prize

6. The winners are chosen by Canonical's marketing team who will select 10 favourites
7. Competition Entries (in their sole discretion). The winners will be announced on the 16th January in a blog and on Twitter
8. [Canonical’s Twitter account @Ubuntu], with instructions to winners on how to claim their prize. The winners will be asked to respond to Canonical confirming their Competition Entry and mailing address to provide instructions on how to receive their prizes. Failure to respond within 72 hours may result in the winner being withdrawn from the Competition and forfeiting their prize.
9. It is the winner’s responsibility to ensure that the correct name and contact details are sent to the Canonical. Canonical accepts no responsibility for a prize sent to an incorrect address (where the details are consistent with what has been advised to Canonical).
10. **Prize:** The 10 winners will each receive the following prize:
  - x1 ticket to attend MWC Barcelona dates: 22 February 2017 - 2 March 2017 with full access to MWC. The prize does not include travel or accommodation to the MWC event.
11. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.

Prizes are subject to availability and legal compliance. Should Canonical not be able to provide the aforementioned prizes, Canonical will use reasonable endeavours to offer an alternative prize of similar price or specification. If Canonical offers an alternative prize, but it is not accepted, then the winner agrees to forfeit the prize.

## **Privacy**

By entering into the Competition you agree to the collection, use and processing of your personal data by Canonical, its group companies and other third parties for the purposes of administering the Competition and for fulfilment/delivery/arrangement of the prize and in accordance with the terms of Canonical's privacy policy:

## **General**

Canonical may suspend the Competition if, or disqualify participants who, engage in fraud or otherwise violate the terms of the Competition. Canonical accepts no responsibility for Competition Entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure of any kind.
